

Care and Maintenance of FiberGraphic™ Table Tennis Tables

Congratulations on the purchase of your custom FiberGraphic™ table tennis table. Periodic cleaning and good storage habits will keep your table looking like new. Here are a few important suggestions that will help you keep your table in the best possible condition for enjoying many years of play.

Cleaning Your Table

Wipe up spilled liquids immediately with a dry, soft cloth.

Once a month, rinse the surface with fresh water and dry it with a soft cloth made of cotton or microfiber.

- You can use mild soap to remove dried spills, etc.
- NEVER use an abrasive cloth or brush to clean your table.

Avoiding Damage to Your Table's Surface

Your FiberGraphic table is made of durable fiberglass and resin. To avoid scratching the tabletop ...

- Keep sharp items away from the table.
- Avoid dragging items across the table surface.
- Don't place hot items on the tabletop.

Removing Stains from Your Table

Most stains can be removed with non-abrasive fiberglass or plastic cleaner.

You can remove grease and oil stains with a mild, non-abrasive household soap.

After the stain is removed, wash the surface using clean water and then dry it with a soft cloth made of cotton or microfiber.

Removing deep stains may harm the surface of your table. For the best playing surface, it may be best to leave deep stains. If you want to remove deep stains from the table ...

- Always start by using the least amount of abrasive to do the job.
- If you remove deep stains by compounding or sanding, it may remove some of the table's gelcoat surface.
- Removing some or all of the surface gel-coat will leave permanent irregularities in the table surface.

Removing Scratches from Your Table

To remove black marks left by paddles or minor scratches from your table top, try Scratch Free Comet®, Bon Ami®, or Bar Keeper's Friend® with plenty of water. Be sure to follow product instructions and follow up with a treatment of Meticulous Matte-brand detailer/sealant.

Maintaining the Finish on Your Table

Once a month, after rinsing and drying the table top or after cleaning stains or removing scratches, apply a coat of detailer/sealant to the table top with a clean cloth made of microfiber.

- We recommend using Meticulous Matte-brand detailer/spray sealant (www.chemicalguys.com) or a similar product.
- We don't recommend waxing your table top. Waxes tend to leave a glossy finish and increase the reflectivity of the table surface. This can make it more difficult to see the ball during game play.

Storing Your Table

If your table is stored outdoors, cover it between uses with a fabric cover to protect the finish from extended periods of direct sun exposure.

- A cover will prolong the life of the surface finish and the table graphics, as well as protect against dust, bird droppings, etc.
- Don't cover the table with anything that doesn't allow moisture to evaporate.
